TURNAGAIN DRILL HOLE ASSAYS - Bren-Mar Resources has reported initial results on hole 97-8, drilled on its 100% owned Turnagain project located 68km northeast of Dease Lake, BC.

The hole intercepted 1.35% nickel, 0.013% cobalt and 0.056% copper over a 1 metre intersection, occurring in a broader mineralized zone from 83 metres to 93 metres averaging 0.36% nickel and 0.16% cobalt over 10 metres.

A second intercept at 128 metres grading 1.39% nickel, 0.052% cobalt, 0.07% copper and 2.8 grams silver/tonne over a 1 metre intersection. This intersection occurs within a broader mineralized zone from 127 metres to 216 metres containing an average of 0.31% nickel and 0.016% cobalt over 89 metres.

The contained metal value of the two high grade intersections are US \$108 and US \$89.76 per tonne respectively.

Hole 97-8 ended in sulphide mineralization and was shut down due to broken casing.

Hole 97-9 was drilled at 500 metres ENE intercepting semi-massive sulphide in 3 different zones with a total width of between 5 and 10 metres. The shallow upper zone begins at 30 metres and the total length of mineralization exceed 300 metres. Results for this hole are pending.

Both holes 97-8 and 97-9 are open at depth and drilling on hole 97-9 will resume weather permitting. The drill rig has been left on site.

Concurrent with additional assays to be received from hole 97-9 the company has commissioned metallurgical testing.

Bren-Mar Resources Ltd. is pursuing its geological model for the Turnagain project of a bulk tonnage, open pit nickel, cobalt, and copper deposit.
