FIRST JEAN PROPERTY-DRILL RESULTS - Gary R. Schell, P. Eng,
 president of Continental

Copper Corp. has reported initial drill results for the Jean porphyry
 copper project located 100 km northwest of Fort St. James, BC.

After building 4 km of road on the property which crossed over the
 "N" induced polarization anomaly on its way to the "A" and "B"
 zones, 3 reconnaissance holes were drilled more than 2,100 feet
 apart for initial evaluation of the "N" anomaly. The drilling
 encountered disseminated sulphides with anomalous copper and gold
 values throughout. Further drilling is necessary to fully evaluate this
 anomaly which measures 5,250 feet by 1,650 feet.
