INDATA DRILLING TO START. J.W. Morton, P.Geo., president, Wildrose Resources Ltd. and optionee Clear Creek Resources Ltd., will begin a diamond drill program 26Feb98 on the Indata property located about 120 km north of Fort St. James; BC. Clear Creek can earn a 51% interest in the property by spending \$1,500,000 on exploration, making cash payments of \$180,000 and issuing 50,000 shares by 31Jul2000. Clear Creek completed an initial \$100,000 drill program in 1996 and is now starting the second program with a \$200,000 budget.

The Indata property, situated in an area of active logging, has been explored by Wildrose and its predecessor company, Eastfield Resources Ltd. since 1987. The 8,300 acre (3,400 hectare) property encompasses a terrane dominated by mafic volcanics and limestone intruded by a number of different intrusive units. Mineralization includes gold and silver in veins and porphyry type copper in mafic volcanics and diorites. Previous drill results have included 1.378 oz. gold/ton over 4 metres from veins and up to 0.12% copper over 97 metres from the porphyry style mineralized andesite and diorite. Higher grade porphyry mineralized rubble grading up to 2.76% copper has been found up slope from previous drilling and is, in part, the focus of the current program.

Clear Creek completed the construction of about two km of road extensions and spurs in January. Fourteen drill sites were constructed from the new roads. (SEE GCNL NO.4, 7Jan98, P.4 FOR INDATA & OTHER PROJECT INFORMATION)

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
