Attached is a copy of a map we received recently from Redhawk Res. It shows the ownership breakdown plotted on the published 1:50,000 map for 82F/3.

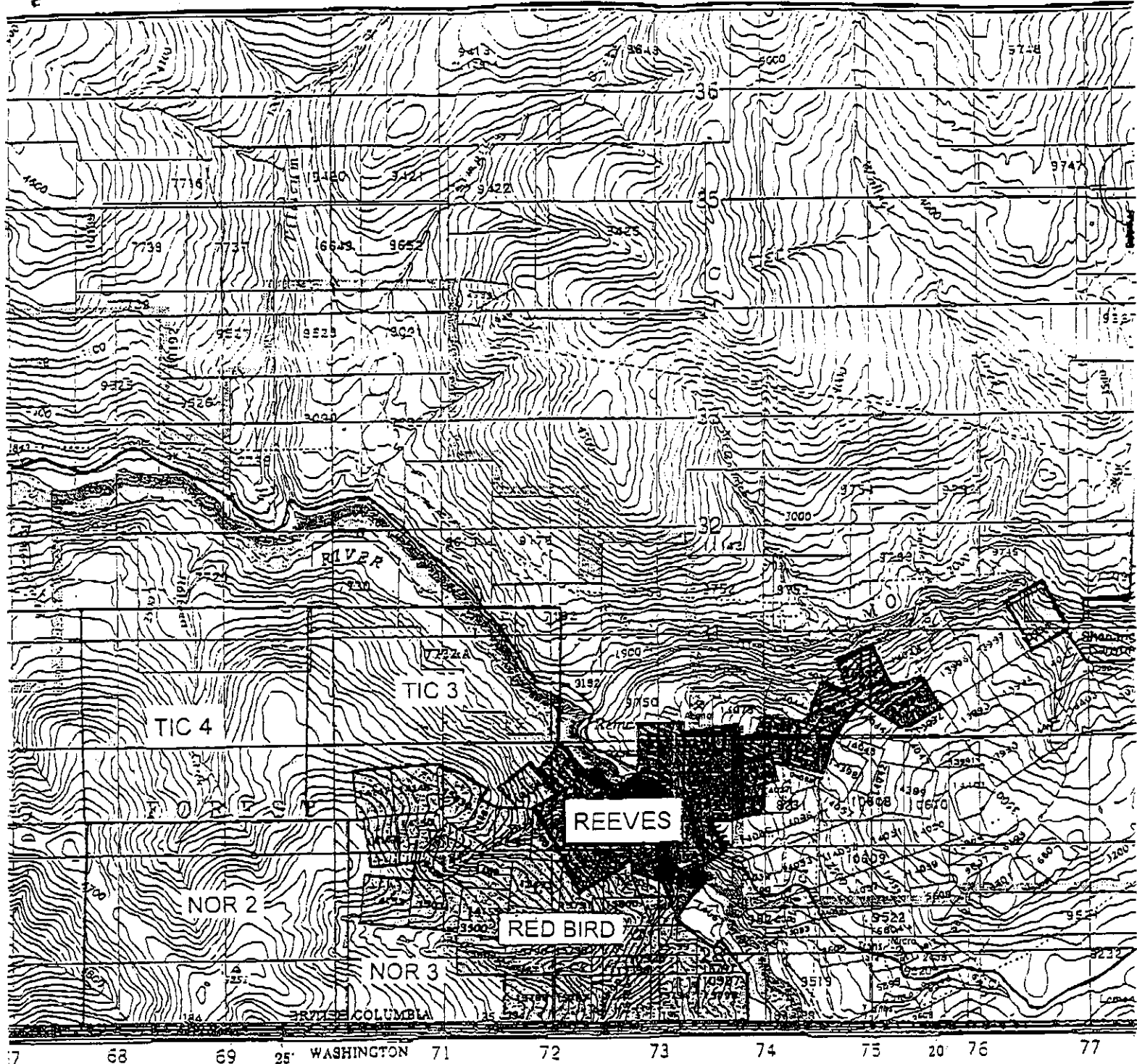
