The Phoenix mine, which closed down 01383
30 Sept 1978, treated 836,336 short tons
of ore in fiscal 1978. It produced
6,855,339 lb copper, 7584 oz gold, and
32,425 oz silver. A total of 515,866 tons
of ore averaging 0.38% copper originated
from the Phoenix low grade stockpiles,
and the remaining 320,470 tons of ore
averaging 0.95% copper were supplied
by the Lone Star operation.

In January 1979, Granby Mining,
Granisle Copper, and Zapata Canada
amalgamated into one company known
as Zapata Granby Corporation.
