PROPERTIES ACQUIRED IN
GREENWOOD AREA OF B.C.

Starlight Energy Corporation have acquired an option to buy the following mineral properties in

Greenwood mining division, B.C., subject to the regulatory approvals: Banner Bullion Rio reverted crown grants and Axe 1-10 mineral claims. Starlight are negotiating the purchase of 12 units which would raise the total claim units held in that area to 25.

These properties are located within the Franklin mining camp, 60 km north of Grand Forks. The well known Union mine there was a major producer between 1913-1946. Geochemical surveys over the Banner claims delineated an anomalous lead-zinc-copper zone some 1,500 feet long between 10 by 10 to 27 ft. wide, open on both ends. Assays of grab samples taken by Starlight's geologist from the Banner dump are shown in the adjoining table.

On 28Feb84, Starlight sold 270,000 shares at 35¢ each to net \$94,500 by way of private placement with president Jacine Levan, subject to regulatory approval.
