

Jvh - Brown Marken visited Aug 30 & 31/84  
- Ken McClay will study structure next  
week with Brown

- Discussed my coming for visit. Showed  
me two specimens. One has rounded,  
milled pyrite clasts of 1-5mm diam in  
matrix of fine sulphide cataclastic mud,  
plus few larger quartz clasts with galena  
in pressure shadows. Schistose matrix  
has quartz-carbonate-sulphide lenses with  
arsenopyrite. Other specimen has  
several aegirine & bands of quartz and  
calcite interwoven with red brown  
ZnS, distinct bands of cataclastic  
quartz pyrite & arsenopyrite. Both specimens  
are highly deformed, high in Pb.

Au values avg ~ 0.2 oz, locally up to 1 oz.

About 2 oz Ag on average.

Ba anomalous, some seen barite in H.W.

Location - N of Revelstoke ~ 50km, turn E just S  
of Cairnes Ck, 10km up road. Left hand fork.
