- original discovery for NR - pyrite +
- 1990 208 ~~mt~~
- several gold veins in low sulphide IP anomaly - ~1-2km from deposit
- eros 0.15 - 0.3%
- crossinal window through Terhak volcanics
- NE edge of Tyaughton Trough
- structures possibly related to
- multiphase Qtz diorite complex intruded andesite to dacite volcanic complex
- no outcrop
- no volcanic markers
- 7 phases of dioritic to Qtz-dioritic
 - phase 1 fig. crowded plg b
 - 2 microdiorite
 - 3 CR porphyry dykes - dip 30 to 60° to S.
 - 4 crosscutting ore and
- andesitic debris flows, fine & coarse ash tuff
- increasingly volcanic lithologies at depth with dykes

- RSL Late thrust imbricates buried against mineralized rock at depth
 - may be related to Hungary Thrust

- vertical fault on south side of deposit - downcross mineralization possibly

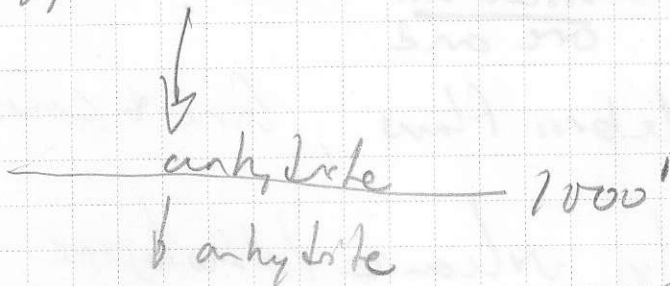
- emphasize vertical fault displacements in interpretation; may not be best way to explain geology

- sericite + carb.
- biotite + magnetite + chlorite
- qtz - calcite
- chlorite - calcite
- quartz + chl. + magnetite

- more biotite + magnetite at depth

- gypsum line at 1320m elevation



- more sericite to south? and west

- 3% total sulphides - py - tr - 10%
 py:cp = 2:1
 p 0.5 - 1.5%
