

Sun Claim Group-McLeese Grub Stake

March 31, 1966

A number of copper occurrences are known in this area associated with the granite and meta sediments. Three of these are indicated on G.S.C. map #12-1959. These have been prospected and investigated intermittently in the past by a number of mining companies.

Current activity in the area is centred on the property of Gibraltar Mines Ltd. which is located immediately NW of the Sue group. Gibraltar is presently operating at least 2 diamond drills on a 10,000' programme. An extensive area of low grade copper sulphide mineralization in the granite intrusive is being explored. Recently published drill core assays from the Gibraltar property are as follows:

The distribution of known copper occurrences in this area and the results of recent exploration activity suggest that the Sue claim group is an area worthy of a preliminary economic investigation.
