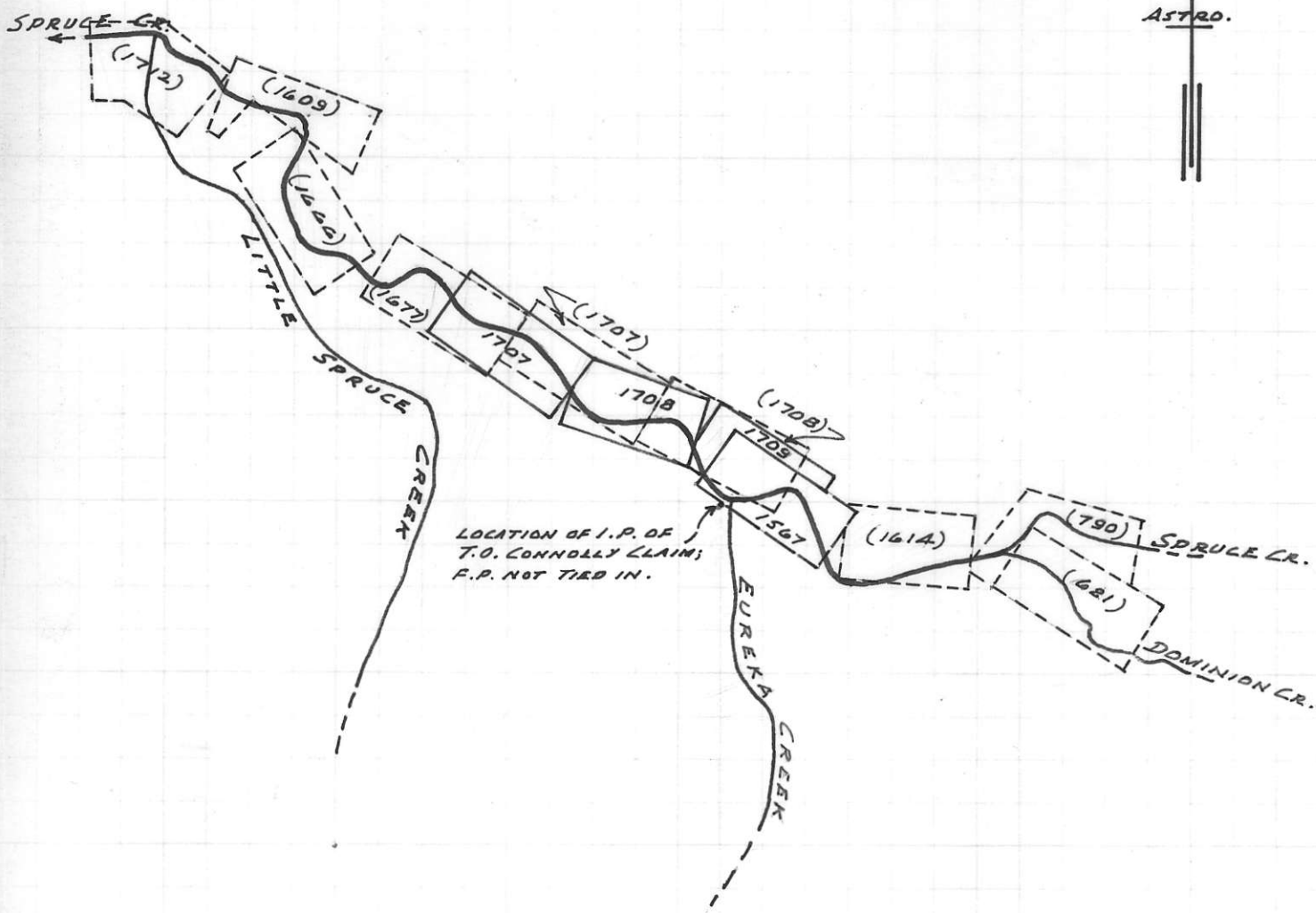

Dear Jim:

I hadn't heard from you regarding your Spruce Creek properties and am still interested in trying to work out an assembly in the area despite the "baddies" in the legislature. The way I look at things, if we can keep our costs down to something like \$50 - \$70 an ounce, even with about \$70 going to the Socialists we should still pick up about \$50 - \$70 per ounce on our own, and while this isn't any bonanza, it is still almost double what could have been made at \$35 gold. There are three ways that the mining bill #31 could be ameliorated:

1. Will pass in a less burdensome form.
2. After a holding period of another two years, a new legislature will throw it out or amend it.
3. The price of gold would hit the area of \$400 per ounce and we'd get half anyway.

With these thoughts I am interested in going forward with our ideas of putting all the claims together in an assembly and attempting to at least work out a proposed program, even though it may have to wait two years for execution because of investor caution. Subsequently I would very much appreciate it if you would prepare the map and other data you mentioned so that we may do something to promote our joint interests. Tom Connolly has one claim on Eureka Creek, #1838, and intends to stake another, both of which he will contribute. As I mentioned in my letter to you of February 13, he has staked another six for me to the West of Spruce Creek along the bench we hope is auriferous.

I also got him to stake 29 claims in the uranium area near yours because of a possible funding I may be able to work out for uranium exploration. This funding is in the U.S. and I have written to the Atomic Energy Control Board in Ottawa for the latest regulations on uranium exploration.
