

Phone conversation w. Bill Hogg, Sept. 11/73.

- Ramp section, pockets + vent. raise to 4690 completed
Note pockets are effecting a savings in undrilled
transport costs.
 - Decline down (advanced) 300'.
 - Expect decline to reach first little fog to left
(where back el. = 4572') by end of Sept.
 - Notes Dirk has done on O.R. estimates (after dil'n) w.
± 15 ½ M tons on major (far) east block (W.S. agrees)
± 10 ½ M tons on block below + east of 4625 H.W. & C.
(W.S. thinks this too high)
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- ± 26,000 tons total.
