Dear Mike:

I found one sample of dark, graphitic, argillaceous(?) lithographic limestone (KQ-87-24A) from the Sulphurets region, B.C. (104 B/8) that I would like checked for conodonts. I would like to know if it is worth collecting more of this type of material this summer (July & August). This is an interturbidite bed in fine grained distal turbidites of possible Triassic age(?).

The sample comes from about 2 km? west of Brucejack Lake in the canyon of Brucejack Creek at UTM location - Zone 09 425 260 East and 6259 030 North.
