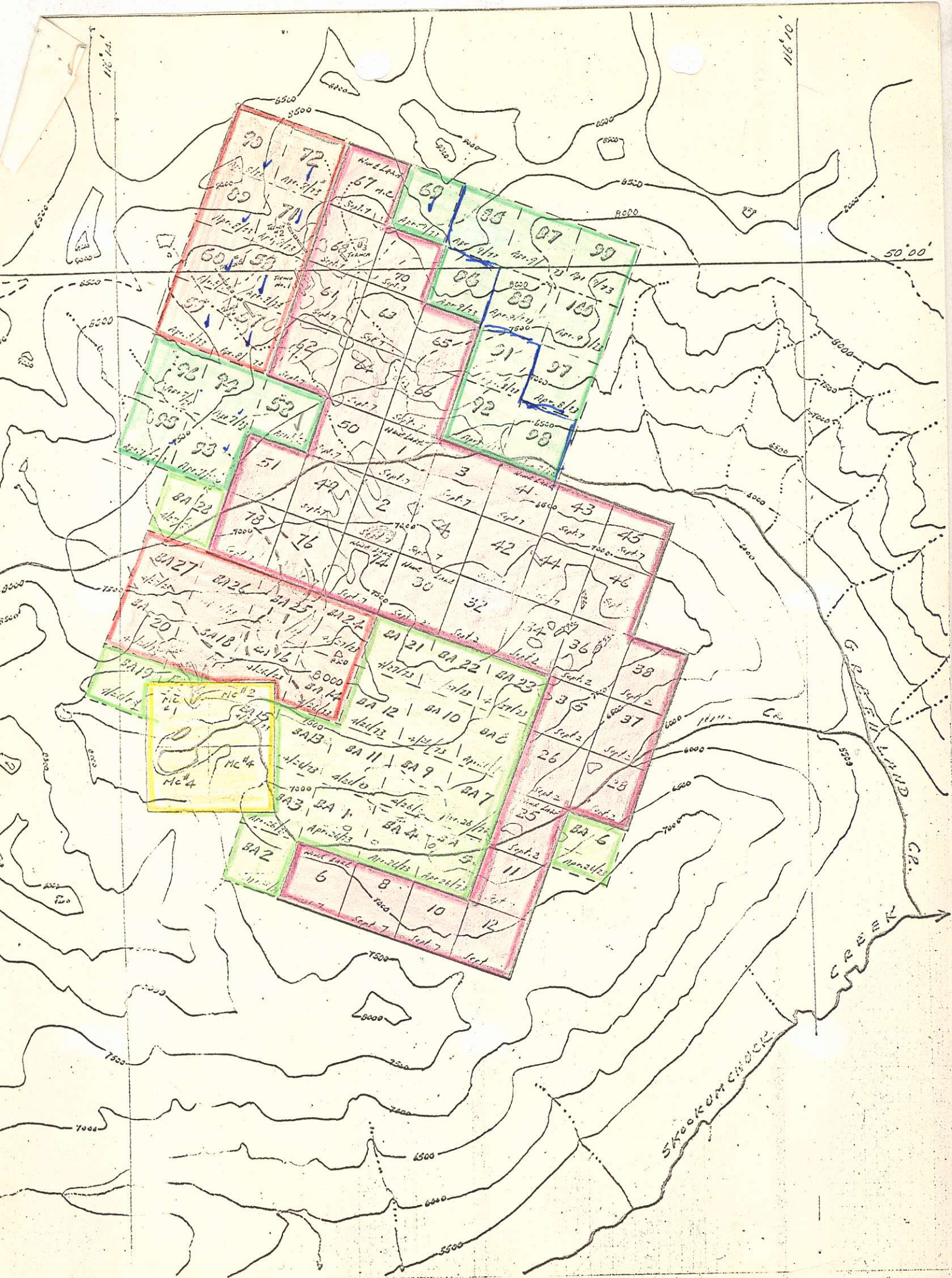

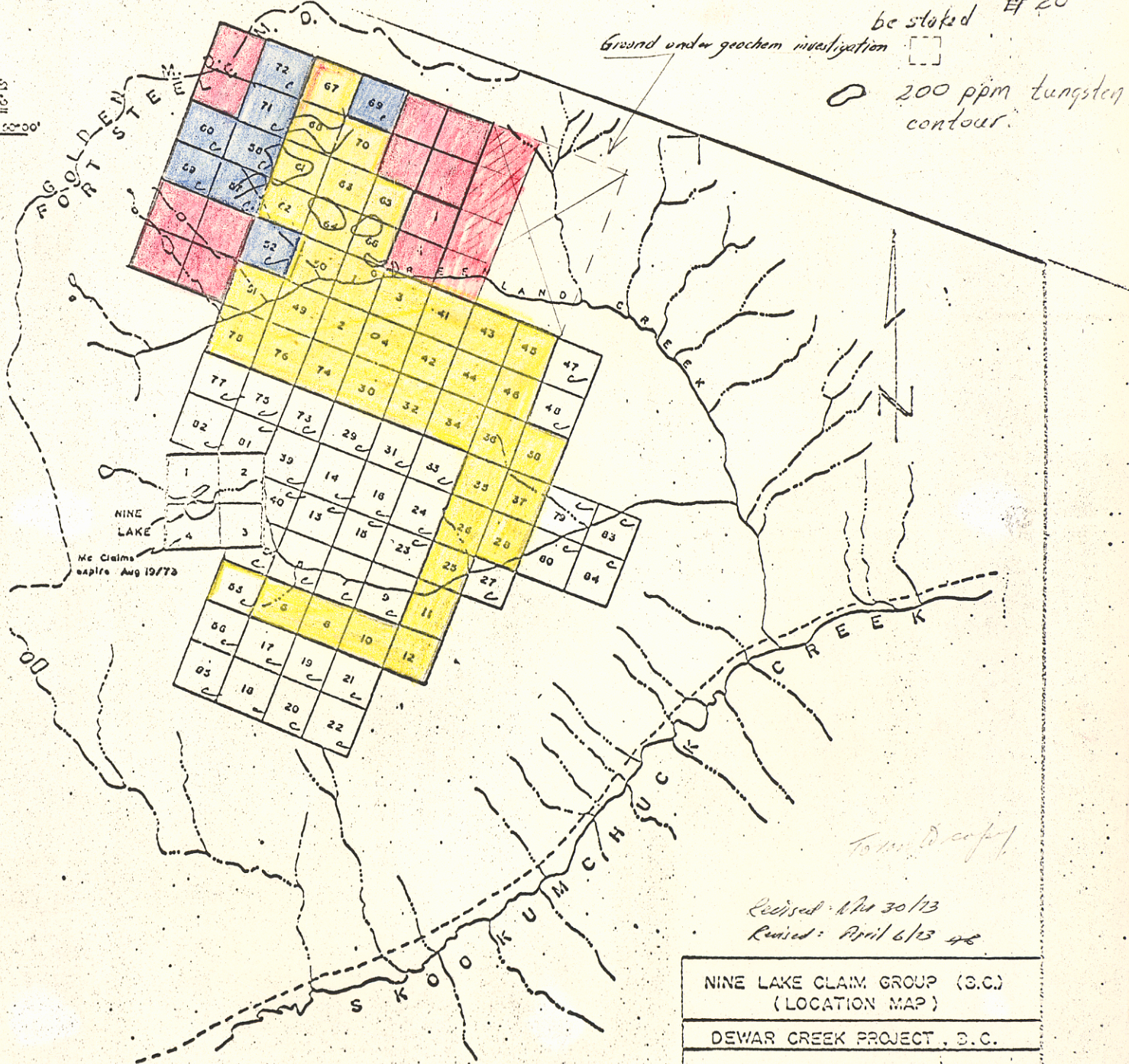

These claims are due for assessment work on September 28, 1974.

The claims were staked to cover an area which contained very high soil anomalies (3,000 ppm of Pb). The surface showings contained quartz veins with fairly coarse galena and these veins cross cut rocks and in some cases followed bedding planes. Some galena was also seen in very black portions of the upper Aldridge shale in the vicinity of the quartz veins.

Detailed mapping last summer by Werner Gruenwald indicated that this black shale unit is only about 50 feet thick and is underlain by argillites and quartzites which contain no mineralized quartz veins.

While it is interesting to speculate on the source of the galena, the environment is topographically very rough and very costly in terms of any contemplated diamond drilling. The elevation of the mineralized outcrop is 8,000 feet, and water supply would be 2,000 feet below the mineralized zone. Furthermore, the Sullivan ore body is 11,000 feet stratigraphically below the zone in which our mineralization occurs.

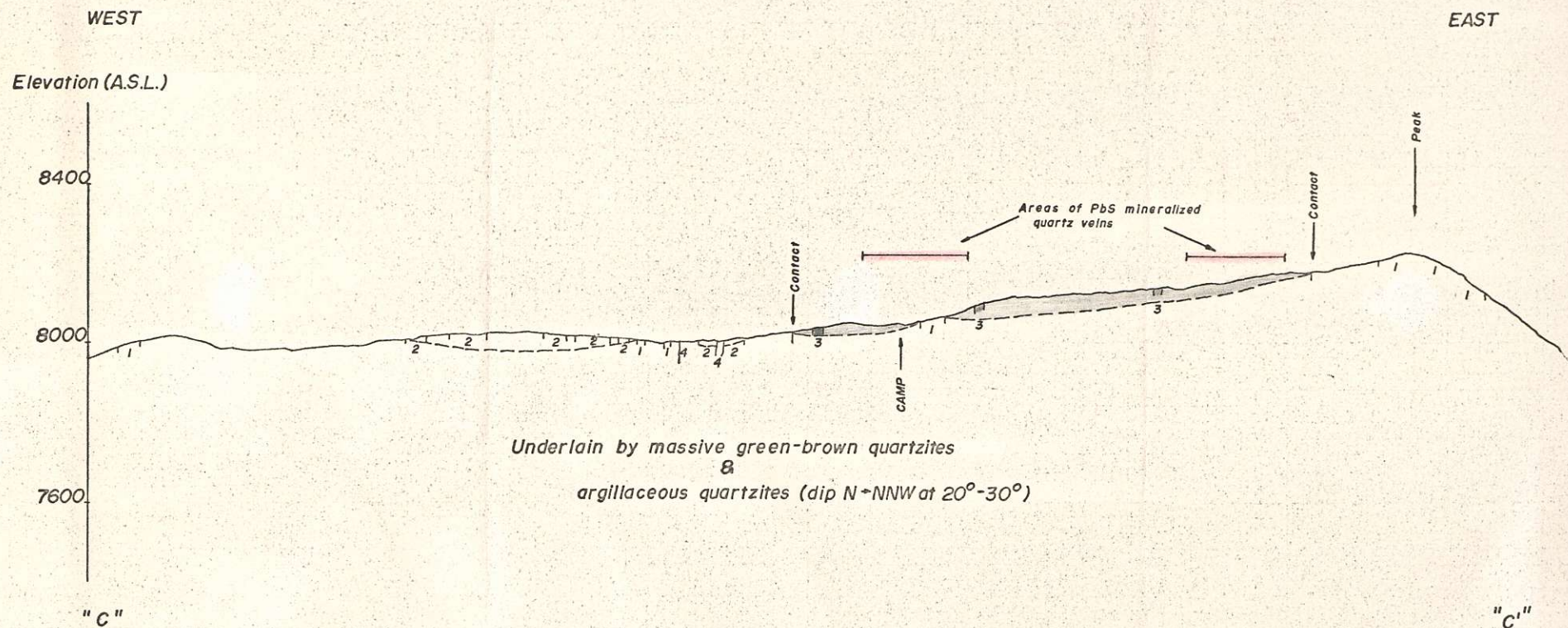
It is entirely possible (because the mineralization occurs on a ridge) that the actual mineral occurrence is very small in area, and gives the impression of being much larger because of mechanical dispersion on both sides of the ridge. In the light of all of these factors, my recommendation is to drop the Doc 1-6 mineral claims.

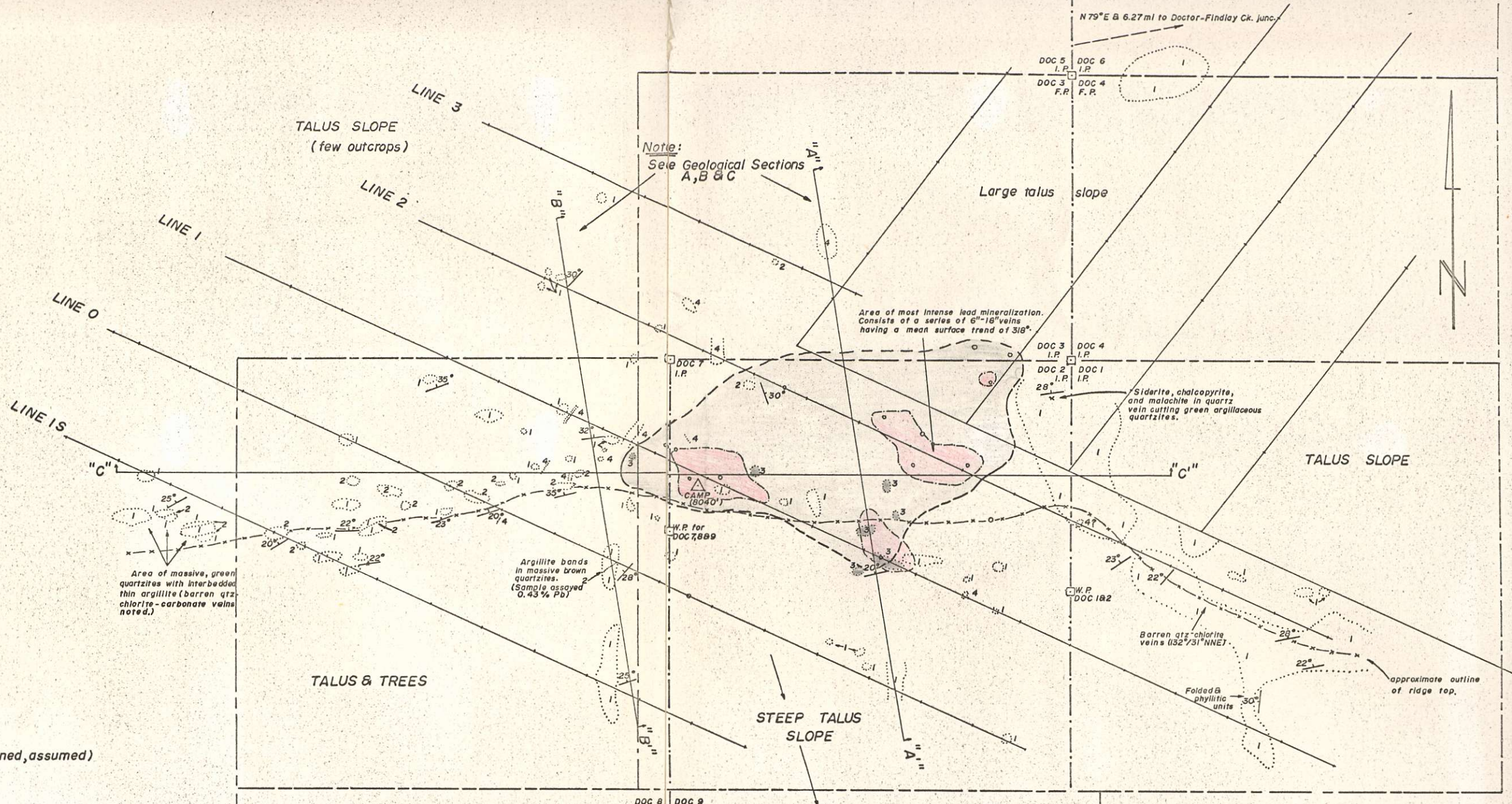

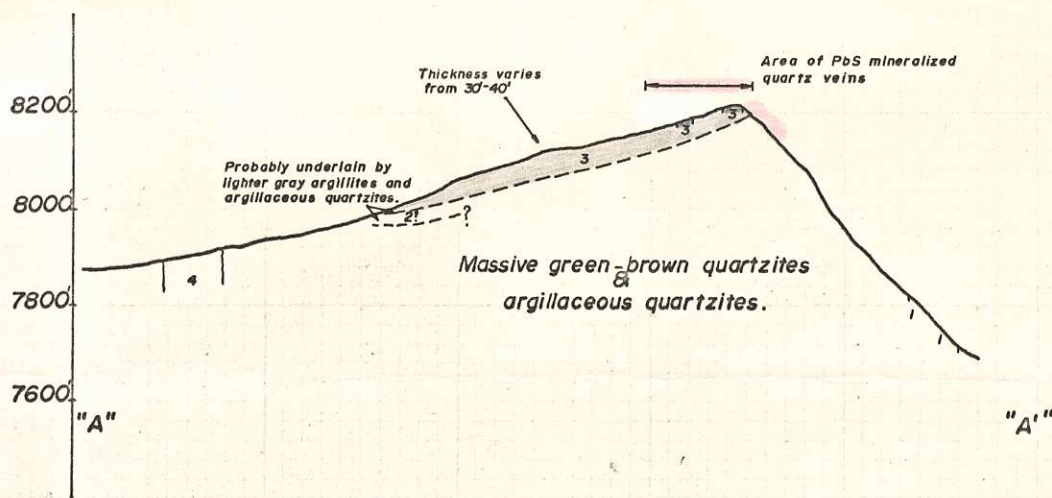
SECTION A-A'

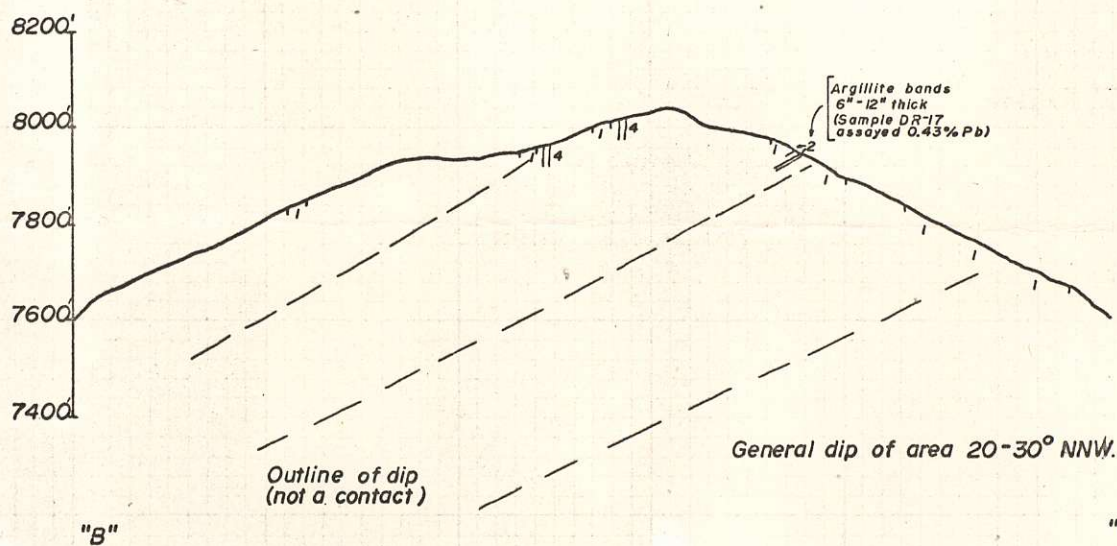

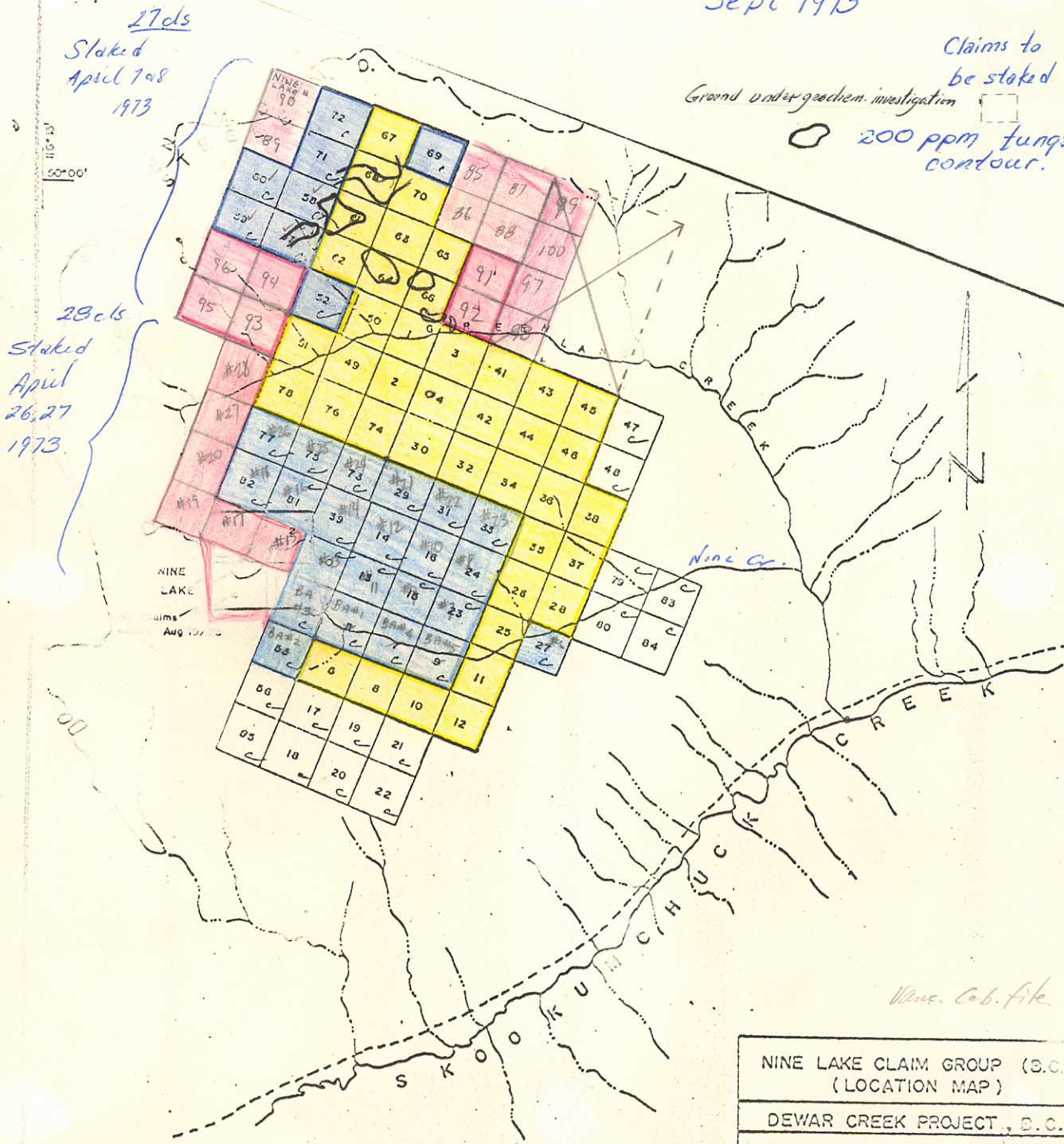
