Re: Dropping EWE Claim - M504

EARL D. DODSON:

The EWE claim was staked on August 31, 1981. It is located 3 kilometers southwest of Tatsamenie Lake on the west side of the Stikine terrain. The claim is underlain on the eastern half by Stikine terrain phyllitic tuffs, with some quartz carbonate alteration, and on the west by a foliated diorite.

Two grab samples were taken from the talus of a silica vein. The samples were analyzed for gold with results of 2050, 3250 ppb gold. No outcrop source for the vein was found. No values were obtained in the soils in the area.

To date a total of \$6,000. US has been spent on the claim block. Since the vein has not been located on the claim block and all of the alteration has been sampled without success, it is recommended that we drop this claim. This claim was discussed with R. Daniel at Tatsamenie Lake and verbal approval was given.
