re: A.B. Claims, Nicola M.D.

As you know we have a light surface drill on the Axel Berglund claims in the Aspen Grove district since May 21. This drill has cut some 800 feet of core in two holes. The first hole was drilled vertically and approximately the center of the four claims. The second hole was directed to east at 50° from the same set up.

The object of the two holes was to determine whether or not any enrichment in copper was present along the west side of the granite and secondly, whether there was any enrichment in the shear at the contact of the granite.

Both questions have now been answered in the negative and we must assume that all the enrichment in the area is confined to rather narrow stringers which occur in minor shears, subsidiary to the main shear. This type of occurrence, it seems, may be standard in the area and as such is of no interest to the company.

The drill was pulled off at the week end and will be used to do assessment work on the H.C. Group on Guichon Creek.
