Dear Mr. Bruce:

Enclosed is a list of claims administered for this project which are held in good standing or which have lapsed during 1983.

Of the remaining claims the BRAN group lies south of the Endako area. High grade silver bearing float had been found in a creek bed here. It has apparently come from narrow quartz-carbonate veins but detailed mapping failed to locate a bed rock source. The general region is favourable for precious metals prospecting - particularly to the south and west but no further work is recommended on this particular claim group.

The SWAB group lies east of BRAN and was staked on uranium and molybdenum geochemical anomalies. Under the terms of the uranium moratorium no further work is permitted. Status of these claims should be reviewed in 1986.
