
**CANADIAN UNITED MINERALS INC.

Derek McBride has reviewed the attached summary report and concludes that the work to date has been productive.

The property is still in the exploration phase and probably requires near 2 million tons of reserves to initiate a silver, lead, zinc operation. At similar ore finding success, ongoing exploration would cost close to \$4 million in 2 or 3 phases.

The property is well situated and Canadian United has 100% control.

A \$½ million flow thru financing program would be in order to further the project - subject to a geological review of all data and the creation of a workable geological structural model.
