Paul,

Just to clarify some of the numbers that I gave you the other day. For the 22 Zone, using a 1 gpt cut-off, there are 350,000 tonnes grading 2.3 gptAu and 90 gptAg, resulting in 250,000 oz Au and 10 M oz Ag. For the 15 gpt cut-off, there are 60,000 tonnes grading 16gpt Au and 550 gpt Ag, resulting in 30,000 oz Au, and 1 M oz Ag.

All of these numbers are confidential and have not been released to the public. Please keep it to yourselves for now until we do make them public.

Great to see you guys and I'll see you at the Round-up if not before.
