Rossland Group andesitic volcanics and tuffaceous sediments Regional: intruded by quartz diorite and monzonite. Diorite porphyry has metamorphised volcanic metasedimentary units to calc-silicate, quartz and carbonate skarn.

Local: Gold occurs in multiple horizons of calc-silicate, quartz-sulfide skarn flanking porphyry sills.

Alteration/

Ore Forming Minerals: Skarn assemblages consist of quartz, plagioclase tremolite-actinolite, clinozoisite, biotite and microline. Free gold occurs within and along the margins of quartz-calc silicate segregations. Variable amounts of pyrrhotite, pyrite, sphalerite and galena may also occur, but are not directly related to gold content.

Current Exploration Results

1987-88

Surface diamond drilling on the East Ridge zone advanced a portion of the drill inferred or geological reserve to a drill indicated or probable category. Underground drifting, cross cutting and diamond drilling took selected reserve blocks to a proven category. Presently defined reserves remain "open" to depth and along strike.

Three other skarn zones have seen exploration with 24 drill holes in one zone returning gold values up to 1.3 ounces per ton over 13 feet.
