- *Tulsequah - Workshop confirmed for February 26-28, 1995 in Vancouver. Redfern has formally dropped transportation options involving road/pipeline to Swede Point. Prospectus addendum forthcoming. Company open houses to be held in Atlin on Feb.15 and Whitehorse Feb.16. MDAP staff to attend. An information letter was distributed to stakeholders and the media.
- Fording Greenhills -KMDRC meeting held February 9th to discuss issues. Final prospectus review to be completed by February 17. Completed terms of reference for application to be completed by march 17. An information letter was distributed to the media.
- *Line Creek Horseshoe Ridge - KMDRC meeting held February 9 to discuss application level issues. Company presented responses to identified concerns, and will follow-up with written addendum within a week. No strategic issues raised. Company holding final meeting with local Fish and Game Club, and will present results of aboriginal and public consultation in addendum.
- Telkwa Coal -ARD workshop tentatively set for February 23, in Vancouver. Care to be taken to ensure discussions with consultant are not perceived to introduce government bias into reports conclusions or independence of author.
- Kemess - Fisheries and ARD reports distributed. MELP may require 4-6 weeks to review.
- Fish Lake - No progress this week. MELP understanding of Ministers' meeting different than that of MEMPR.
- Huckleberry -All prospectus review comments submitted and provided to company. Terms of reference document being prepared.
- Elk Pit -Application being distributed.
- Montieith Bay - MDC and Reasons for Decision being reviewed by MELP staff.
- Bralorne - MDC and Reasons for Decision documentation completed and under final review.
- Mount Meagher Pumice - Application review completed. MDC and Reasons for Decision nearly complete.
