## VANANDA GOLD LTD. (VAG-V)

FIRST 1993 DRILL HOLE CUTS COPPER - Stanley Beale, president, Vananda Gold Ltd., reports the first drill hole of the 1993 exploration season has intersected about 25 meters (from 363-388 meters) of endo-skarn containing chalcopyrite on the Texada Island property located in Georgia Strait

about 75 miles northwest of Vancouver, B.C. Drilling was suspended while still in the zone due to frozen waterlines. Drilling of this hole is expected to resume shortly and be completed within 24 hours.

DDH 93-60 is about 100 meters east of DDH 92-59 and is on Line 10 at the Northwest Diorite, a chargeable zone about 1.5 km long and 450 meters wide. Surface samples 200 meters directly south of DDH 92-58 on Line 8 returned one meter of greater than 1% copper and 2.0 grams gold/tonne. At the northern boundary of this chargeable zone, along the Holly fault near Line 16, assays as high as 0.7 oz.gold/ton over 0.5 meters were recorded.
