CACTUS WEST EXPLORATIONS LTD. (CWE-V)

DRILLING RESUMED - Cactus West Explorations Ltd. has resumed drilling on the Lupus gold property next to Better Resources on Mt. Washington near Courtenay, Vancouver Island. Interests are: Cactus 50% Panworld 35%, Proquest 15%. A 2000-foot drilling program is now underway in the Creek Zone where previous drilling by Cactus encountered significant gold values:

87L-7	7.2 ft	12 oz.gold/ton and
87L-8	8.1 ft.	17 oz.gold/ton.

DELAWARE RESOURCES CORP. (DLW-V)

UNDERGROUND EXPLORATION EXPECTED - R.K. Metolitsky, a director of Delaware Resources Corp., reports that 30 new drill holes were completed up to 22 July 87 on the SNIP gold joint venture project with Cominco Ltd. some 60 miles NW of Stewart in NW B.C. This work tested exploration targets over a 3000 by 1500 foot area with widely spaced holes. Visual logging of drill core and limited geochemical and fire assays currently available have traced the Twin Structural Zone, which contains the Twin, Tara, and Rope zones as defined by the 1986 drilling, over a minimum horizontal distance of 3000 feet and a vertical interval of 1500 feet. Fire assay results from diamond drill hole 36 showed 13.8 feet grading 0.488 oz.gold/ton. The drill fence with holes 35, 37 and 39 intersected very well mineralized structures with visible gold observed in DDH-35 and 37 (assays pending). The surface geological program has located new mineralized zones, two of which will be drill tested. Surface samples from one of these zones returned values of 0.872, 0.314 and 0.215 oz/ton gold. The objectives of the balance of the program are: to drill off the Twin Structural Zone with 50-metre spaced fences; to continue drilling the Lamp zone and to drill test at least two of the new surface targets.

Delaware management is confident that the next phase of exploration will include an underground exploration program.

WINDFLOWER MINING LTD. (WFL-V)

NEW ZONE DISCOVERED - Gerald Ryznar, P.Eng., president of Windflower Mining Ltd., has reported discovery of a new mineralized zone of quartz-carbonate vein and quartz stockwork along Scott Creek, some 500 metres north of the gold bearing quartz vein presently being drilled. The Goldfinch property is 50 km southeast of Revelstoke B.C. The dimensions of the new zone are impressive, extending for a strike length of 500 metres with widths generally 3 to 4 metres and occasionally as wide as 10 metres. Assays of grab samples and narrow chip samples have varied from 0.09 oz. to .78 oz.gold/ton). Preparations are underway for an immediate program of surface trenching prior to diamond drill testing.
