Newhawk Gold Mines Ltd. has received assays from underground development at the Sulphurets property 50 km north of Stewart, B.C. The property is owned 60% by Newhawk, the operator, and 40% by Granduc Mines Ltd.

Underground crews completed a raise from the 1150-meter level up to the 1200-meter level in the R-8 structure. In addition, a 14.7-foot sub drift was driven from the raise across the R-8 at about the 1178-foot elevation. See table for sampling results.

The path followed by the raise crosses the R-8 structure from its starting point near the hanging wall in the crosscut on the 1150 level, which averaged 0.294 oz.gold/ton and 4.99 oz.silver/ton across 38 feet. The raise and sub drift identified a very high grade lens at least 16.5 feet wide. The face of the sub drift remained in mineralization and a further advance is planned to test the true width. A 15,000-foot underground diamond drilling program is underway to confirm reserves in R-8 and expand reserves. (SEE GCNL Nos. 186, 167 AND 163 FOR EARLIER INFORMATION)
