HOLE STOPPED - John A. Greig, president, reports Redfern Resources Ltd., 40%, has been informed by Cominco Ltd., 60%, operator of the Tulsequah Chief project located about 40 miles east of Juneau, Alaska in northwest B.C., that drill hole 90-29 has been stopped at a depth of 2,625 feet. It was drilled into footwall andesites and no mineralization was encountered. This hole was originally designed to test the eastern portion of the H lens 400 feet down dip from hole 90-23; however, it deviated considerably to the east to the extent that it is probably beyond the eastern edge of the H zone. The footwall andesites were encountered sooner (higher) than expected, indicating there is some uplift on the east side. It is not known whether this is due to doming or faulting. The results are currently being assessed. After a Christmas break, it is planned to continue work on the property to complete hole 90-28 which, like hole 29, had encountered technical difficulties. The same techniques will be used to complete hole 28 as were used in hole 29. Hole 28 is targeted toward the centre of the H lens. (SEE GCNL No.226, 22Nov90, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)

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
