KATIE EXPLORATION RESULTS - Ken Murray, director, reports  
YellowJack Resources Ltd.

has received exploration results from its 100%-owned  
Katie property located at the headwaters of Hellroaring  
Creek near Salmo, B.C. The work included 305 meters of  
drilling and 1,200 meters of trenching that was  
concentrated on a shear zone. An area 500 by 600 meters  
with copper values over 200 parts per million was not  
tested. Regional stream sediment geochemistry indicates  
the creek draining the property is anomalous in copper  
values. A heavy mineral sample also returned gold  
values of 2,500 parts per billion from the same creek.

Values in the shear zone include 1.0% copper and  
0.06 oz.gold/ton as well as 0.23% copper and 0.02  
oz.gold/ton. Other values range between 0.12% and 0.40%  
copper. In trench #1, copper averaged 0.19% over 28  
meters and trench #3 averaged 0.16% copper over 42  
meters. In another part of trench #3, two samples  
averaged 0.35% copper, and due to deep overburden, the  
samples were 24 meters apart with ground in between
