**KINGHORN ENERGY CORP. (KHR-V)**

1990 PROGRAM COMPLETED - David J. Kotula, director,  
reports Kinghorn Energy Corp.

has completed its \$150,000 1990 exploration program on  
its joint venture mineral properties located between  
seven and 15 km west of the Prime/Stikine Easkay Creek  
discovery some 60 miles northwest of Stewart, B.C.

Kinghorn is earning 50% interests in the properties.

Prospecting, reconnaissance geological mapping with  
rock and stream sediment sampling has been completed on  
the AY 1,2 and Au 1 and 2 claims which revealed  
interbedded andesite tuffs, siltstone and limestone cut  
by many narrow quartz/carbonate veins in east-west  
oriented fractures or along dyke contacts. On the AY 1  
claim, veins assayed up to 1.890 and 0.248 oz. gold/ton  
over 15 and 30-cm widths from grab samples. Values up  
to 2,000 parts per billion gold were returned from grab  
samples on the Au 2 claim. (SEE GCNL No.156, 14Aug90,
