TULSEQUAH CHIEF UPDATE - John A. Greig, president, Redfern Resources Ltd., 40%, and joint venture partner Cominco Ltd., 60%, report assays have been received from hole 90-23, which intersected the H-lens 500 feet down-dip from hole 90-22 at the drilling program on the Tulsequah Chief project located in northwest B.C., about 40 miles east of Juneau, Alaska. The true width of the intersection is 62 feet. The true width of the 164-foot intersection in hole 90-22 has been revised upward to 130 feet from the previously reported 110 feet.

Drilling is at the 1,000-foot mark in hole 90-24, which is targeted to intersect the new H-lens mineral zone 300 feet west of hole 90-23. A second drill, recently mobilized to the property, is expected to begin immediately by drilling of hole 90-25, which is targeted to intersect the H-lens 300 feet east of hole 90-22.

In light of the outstanding results in the first two 1990 drill holes, Redfern considers geological reserves are now about 10,000,000 tons with a potential for 20,000,000 tons considered realistic. (SEE GCNL No.170, 4Sep90, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)

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
