NORTH SLOPE MINERALS INC. (NHS-V)

NO SIGNIFICANT ASSAYS - Kenneth MacLeod, president of North Slope Minerals Inc., has reported initial assays from the drill program on the Murex property near Courtenay on Vancouver Island, B.C., showed no significant results. North Slope has an option to earn 50% interest in the property from BETTER RESOURCES LTD. (BRZ-V). The company has drilled a fan of three holes down-dip from hole NMX-89-25 which had been drilled by Noranda Exploration company in 1989, and intersected 4 metres of 0.18 oz/ton and 4.06% copper. The drill has been relocated to the site of hole NMX-89-26 which was also initially drilled by Noranda and intersected 6.5 metres of 0.006 oz.gold/ton and 1.07% copper. A fan of two holes totalling 200 metres is being drilled to determine continuity of structure and mineral content down-dip from NMX-89-26.
