ANOTHER GOOD INTERSECTION - Bruce McKnight, vice president, corporate affairs, reports Westmin Resources has obtained another excellent drill intersection about 200 meters southeast of the Gap zone at Buttle Lake, Vancouver Island, B.C. Hole 14-907 (-83° south), drilled on section 15+85E, encountered high grade material about 30 meters south of the intersection obtained in hole 14-906.

The discoveries on holes 14-906 and 907 are now thought to be separate from Gap zone ore and are probably part of new, flat-lying, H-W style lenses. This lens has tentatively been named the Battle zone. Westmin continues drilling in the Gap-Battle area with three machines on a single shift basis.

Westmin has received government approval for a 16-hole surface diamond drilling program to test the eastern extensions of the H-W ore zones. The program will start the first week of January. (SEE GCNL No.215, 7Nov91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS DRILL RESULTS)
