FAIRVIEW/STEMWINDER DRILLING TO START - Lawrence J.

Nagy, president,
reports Oliver Gold Corp. will begin a 3,300-foot
diamond drilling program in mid-January on the 100%
owned Fairview/Stemwinder property located five km
northwest of Oliver in south-central B.C.

Previous drilling by Oliver indentified several
high grade, gold-bearing, ore shoots in the Brown Bear
adit and Stemwinder shaft areas. The drilling program
is designed to upgrade the shoots to drill indicated
status and assist in determining the position of an
exploratory raise from an existing drift below the ore
shoots. Limited previous drill holes from this area

suggest grades of 0.30 to 0.50 oz.gold/ton and 2.0 to
4.0 oz.silver/ton in quartz veins up to 5.0 feet wide
may be present. Depending on the results of this drill
program, work on the raise is also expected to be
