FURTHER MYRA FALLS ASSAYS- Bruce McKnight, vice president reports Westmin Resources Ltd. has received assays for another drill hole at the Myra Falls operations 90 km west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. As was hole 15-449, hole 15-450 was drilled on Section 12+60E at -80° south. The hole encountered the ore zone about 15 meters north of the discovery hole on this section. See 15-450 below:

Another in-fill hole on this section has been started, drilling -85° south. On Section 14+00E, hole 14-717 drilling -62° north also encountered high grade massive sulphides, which were intersected over a core length of 26 meters and look similar to those in discovery hole 14-713 which hit the ore at about 18 meters to the south. The hole is still drilling and assays should be available by July 12. Hole 14-901, on Section 15+85E, drilling -50° north has encountered sporadic zones of ore grade mineralization. Assays are pending. The next hole on this section has started drilling -71° north. (SEE GCNL No.125, 28Jun91, P.2 FOR PREVIOUS DRILL RESULTS)
