FAIRVIEW DRILL RESULTS - Lawrence J. Nagy, president, reports Oliver Gold Corp. has received assays from its 21-hole, 1,471-meter diamond drilling program on its 100%-owned Fairview project six km NW of Oliver, B.C. The program tested for extensions of known higher grade gold-bearing ore shoots in the

Brown Bear adit area and to test an unexplored area extending 500 meters southeast of the Brown Bear adit toward the old Morning Star workings. Hole SC91-21, one of four holes reporting significant gold/silver values over a strike length of 300 meters, may indicate the presence of a previously unrecognized ore shoot. The table above lists significant intersections. All holes except B91-03 and 14 intersected the target hangingwall quartz vein. Hole B91-01, 04, 05, 06, 12, SC91-18, 19 and MS91-20 did not intersect metal values. Hole B91-03 was collared to test the footwall vein only and hole B91-14 was abandoned. Additional drilling is being considered for later this season on the possible ore shoot southeast of the Brown Bear adit to test its down-dip continuity.
