WESTMIN RESOURCES LTD. (WMI-V.I.M)

MYRA FALLS ASSAYS IN - Bruce McKnight, vice president, corporate affairs, reports Westmin Resources Ltd. has received assay results from underground drilling at the Lynx mine at the Myra Falls operations located 90 km inland from Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. The drill hole encountered 39.3 meters of massive sulphide mineralization of which 33.1 meters returned a density-length-weighted average assay

of 3.6 grams gold/tonne, 365 grams silver/tonne, 4.5% copper, 0.5% lead and 18.5% zinc. The hole is 400 meters east of the Ridge zone and 1,300 meters west of the H-W deposit. The mineralization is believed to be in upper H-W mine stratigraphy. The elevation of the new zone is above that of the H-W mine workings and thus can be developed without expensive shaft sinking. Additional holes are being planned to follow the new zone both across the section and along strike to define its extent. (SEE GCNL No.88, 7May91, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS INFORMATION)
