WESTMIN RESOURCES LTD. (WMI-V,T,M)

ADDITIONAL MASSIVE - Bruce K. McKnight, vice president, **SULPHIDES DRILLED** reports West-Min Resources Ltd. has encountered massive sulphide mineralization on Section 12+60E, some 140 meters west of the discovery hole reported in GCNL Nos.88 and 91, 1991, as 33.1 meters of 3.6 grams gold/ tonne, 365 grams silver/ tonne, 4.5% copper, 0.5% lead, 18.5% zinc. The mineralization is of a similar style, character and structural/stratigraphic position as the previous hole making it likely to be part of the same lens.

The new hole penetrated a fault into seven meters of massive sulphides comprising sphalerite, pyrite and bornite. The hole has been stopped in the zone to stabilize the fault with cement and will be continued shortly to test the full extent of the sulphides and the stratigraphy below.

The original drill is still working on Section 14+00E, the discovery section. After the discovery hole, a hole drilled to the north had to be abandoned in hanging wall fault material and another hole has been collared to the south and should be reaching its target on 22May91. A third drill is to be moved into position on Section 15+80E and should be drilling within a week to test the zone to the east. (SEE GCNL No.92, 13May91, P.1 FOR FIRST QUARTER REPORT)
