DRILLING TO RESUME IN SEARCH - Barkhor Resources Inc. 50%
FOR SULLIVAN LOOK-A-LIKE and Chapleau Resources
Ltd. 50% have completed

the initial six holes of the Darlin claims located 12km
southwest of Cominco's Sullivan Mines, at Kimberley, B.C.

These holes intersected numerous bands of sulphides
up to 2 feet over a 900 foot stratigraphic interval
including chlorite and albite alteration associated with
the sulphide beds similar to that associated with the
Sullivan Mine bedded sulphide deposit. In two holes,
D91-5 and 6, two beds of sulphides have tentatively been
correlated which show a marked thickening of the
sulphides to the south. Unfortunately, these holes were
not accessible to the down hole probe.

Down hole geophysics on holes D90-2 and 3 has
indicated correlation of the geophysical responses with
sulphide beds and an off hole conductor respectively.
The off hole conductor from preliminary analysis is
associated with the main conductive zone identified

previously.

Additionally geophysical surveying along strike to
the west is ongoing.

Drilling of an additional 5000-6000 feet in 6 to 10
holes will start in November. The drilling will test
these off hole anomalies, the thickening to the south
and the additional anomalies being identified to the west.
Total expenditures to date are approximately \$150,000
with an additional expenditure of \$150,000 expected to
test extension of currently identified zones.

This expenditure by Barkhor Resources Inc. will
earn the company 50% interest in the Darlin claims.
