MORE VISIBLE GOLD AT MYRA FALLS - Walter Segsworth,
president, reports

Westmin Resources has encountered more visible gold in
Gap step-out drilling at the Myra Falls mining
operations located 90 km west of Campbell River,
Vancouver Island, B.C. Hole 14-720 was drilled off-
set 38 meters to the east from section 14+00 and
encountered 15.3 meters of ore visually estimated to
grade 2.5% copper and 22% zinc with visible gold.
Assays will be available about Oct.14.

The drifting towards the Gap discovery is advancing

on a three-shift basis from the H-W mine 18 level. A
contract has just been let to drill a raise bore hole
from surface to the 18 level to provide additional
ventilation to permit the use of of more equipment to
