## WILLIAMS CREEK EXPLORATIONS LTD. (WCX-V) ENCOURAGING GOLD RESULTS - Duane Poliquin, president, FROM NEW DRILL PROGRAM Williams Creek Explortions has reported on the recently completed five hole, 2,600 foot diamond drill program on the 100% owned, Crown granted Westport claims at Wells-Barkerville, 60 miles east of Quesnel, B.C. These holes were laid out to test the Blackjack adit area, which produced 200 tons of 0.85 oz. gold per ton, the only previous drilling, in 1947, encountered significant values. The veins and zones encountered in drilling are typical of the orthogonal type veins found in the adjoining and formerly producing Cariboo Gold Quartz and Island Mountain mines. Orthogonal oriented veins are the main source of high grade gold in the camp. HOLE INTERVAL WIDTH ASSAY All holes are -45 de-FEET GOLD 02/T'grees, to cut the vein at NO. FEET 9.5 59.5-69.0 0.456 'right angles. Holes 2 604.25-606.0 1.75 .489 'and 5 are outermost and 'about 350 feet apart. .174 664.5-669.3 4.8 2 299.2-301.1 1.9 .107 'Hole 3 (-65 degrees) was .250 'drilled at right angles 424.0-437.0 13.0 .974 78.8-85.6 6.8 'to the other holes to 200.0-205.0 5.0 .749 'test a vein intersected .395 'in 1947 drilling that 240.0-244.0 4.0 ------appeared to be in a cross structure, and was reported to contain 9.0 feet of 0.76 opt gold. This vein was cut and contained sulphide mineralization, but returned no significant assays.

The mineralization style, widths and grades are similar to the vein zones mined on the adjacent properties which produced 1,200,000 oz. gold. The drilling has confirmed the potential of the Blackjack zone. The claims have known zones that merit drilling.
