SKY CREEK DRILLING REPORT - Murray Pezim, chairman,
Adrian Resources Ltd.,

reports on the progress of the initial phase of drilling on the Sky Creek project located immediately south of the SNIP mine and adjoining the Skyline Johnny Mountain property in the Iskut River area of northwest B.C. Adrian can earn a 51% interest in the property by spending \$1,600,000 on exploration, issuing 200,000 shares and granting Skyline options to buy 150,000 shares of Adrian at prices varying from \$2.75 to \$4.75 per share over three years.

Adrian began the program with six closely-spaced diamond drill holes testing the SMC zone discovery, over an area some 20 by 30 meters centred on Trench 02. The holes were planned to determine the attitude of the SMC zone prior to starting more widely-spaced step-out holes along strike and to depth. Five of the holes have intersected mineralization typical of the SMC zone. Holes SC91-01 to 03 each encountered upper and lower zones of sulphide mineralization; core lengths for the intercepts ranged from 4.5 to 14 meters. Holes SC91-04 and 05 each intersected a single zone of mineralization,

13.9 meters and 8.5 meters wide respectively. Preliminary examination of the sixth hole indicates no sulphides were intersected.

Mineralization in the first five holes is dominantly sphalerite and pyrite with lesser amounts of galena and chalcopyrite, similar to the disseminated to semi-massive sulphide mineralization observed in Trench 02. Channel samples from Trench 02 returned averages of 0.119 oz.gold/ton, 1.14 oz.silver/ton, 2.06% lead, 5.15% zinc and 0.23% copper across 54.1 feet. Drilling is now underway at the Tillerman showing.
