DIAMOND DRILL PROGRAMME COMPLETE - Hisway Resources

has reported Cameco Corporation of Saskatoon, Sask. has completed a diamond drilling program on the Holberg Inlet property near Port Hardy, Vancouver Island, B.C.

Six drill holes (731.2 m) tested soil and IP anomalies in three widely separated areas designated Dorlon, HPH and Contact Creek. Drill cores from holes testing the Dorlon and HPH areas returned a maximum of 0.69% zinc over 0.5 m. In the Contact Creek area, an interval in hole 91-05 containing fracture controlled sulphide veinlets within an altered intrusive returned 6.4% zinc, 0.4% copper over 4.0 m. Hole 91-06, 600 m to the west and testing a different IP anomaly, returned 2.8% zinc over 2.0 m from sulphide-bearing skarned sediments adjacent to a felsic intrusive.

The drill report is being finalized and data from the 1991 field programs are being re-evaluated.
