MYRA FALLS TONNAGE ADDED - Westmin Resources Ltd. reports significant new tonnages of high grade copper ore has been found at its Myra Falls milling operations west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. A drilling program has been ongoing since last year which began at the Gap zone and continued east into the Battle zone. The drilling encountered copper grades some 20% higher than the company is currently mining. Presently, the Gap zone has an estimated 637,000 tonnes with 304,300 tonnes grading 2.9 grams gold/tonne, 178.4 grams silver/tonne, 2.4% copper and 15% zinc. The remaining tonnage is believed to be about the same grade. The Battle zone hosts 2,700,000 tonnes grading 1.37 grams gold/tonne, 43.5 grams silver/tonne, 2.94% copper and 14.75% zinc. The Myra Falls operations have generated \$2.1 billion since 1966 from mining 12,700,000 tonnes of ore. (SEE GCNL No.114, 12Jun92, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS MYRA FALLS INFORMATION)
