has reported assays from drilling on the Battle zone at the Myra Falls mining operation west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C. See table above. The length of the intercept should be close to true width. The copper and zinc grades are significantly higher than earlier visual estimates. As well, an additional two meters at the bottom of the intersection was ore grade.

Hole 14-725, drilling on Section 16+92E and inclined -82 degrees north, has encountered massive sulphide ore. The intersection, which extends from 271.3-280.6 meters (9.3 meters), is visually estimated to contain 3% copper and 9% zinc. Assays should be available in a few days. A new hole has been started, inclined -70 degrees south, on this section and other Battle zone test holes are in progress on Sections 13+72E and 15+85E. The Battle zone is still open to the east and west. (SEE GCNL No.52, 13Mar92, P.1 FOR PREVIOUS DRILL RESULTS)
