MOSQUITO CONSOLIDATED GOLD MINES LIMITED (MOQ-V)

WELLS B.C. PLACER - Mosquito Consolidated Gold Mines
LEASES FARMED OUT Ltd. has granted Edward Asp &
Associates of Dease Lake, B.C. a

license to placer mine on 4 mineral crown grants and 3
placer mining leases located at Wells, B.C. Edward Asp
& Associates will make minimum advance royalty payments
of \$25,000 every 6 months. These payments will be
credited towards a 10% gross royalty on all gold or
other valuable minerals produced from the property.

Since the discovery of Placer gold on Mosquito
Creek sometime prior to 1885 until recently, Mosquito
Creek has yielded a reported 307,000 ounces of gold.
Mosquito Creek is believed to be the richest creek for

its length in the prolific Barkerville placer camp. In
1989 Mosquito Consolidated Gold Mines Ltd. completed 7
churn drill holes (972 feet) which resulted in locating
the extension of the Mosquito Creek channel. A six
meter section above bedrock yielded 0.18 oz/cut/yd. A
seismic survey has been completed and final
pre-production drilling will commence on 17Mar92.
