**EXPLORATION RESULTS REVIEWED - Kenrich Mining and
Ambergate Explorations**

have reported receipt of Placer Dome's Exploration Ltd. final report on the Kenrich, Ambergate jointly owned Cumberland prospect on the South Unuk River, Sulphurets Creek area, 40 km north of Stewart, B.C.

In Sept. 1991 Placer Dome conducted geological mapping of the prospect and adit, whole rock and soil geochemistry, re-examination of diamond drill core and magnetometer and YLF surveys. The work indicated the property is underlain by Betty Creek Formation and that the mineralization is of gold enriched Kuroko type volcanogenic massive sulphides. The sulphide body occurs in a fault zone, and is considered to have been segmented to the northwest of Sulphurets Creek.

Further exploration has been recommended north of Sulphurets Creek to pursue the continuity of the massive sulphides. The Cumberland prospect is one of several on the property. A final report is expected in a few weeks.

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
