BATTLE ZONE EXTENDED - Bruce K. McKnight, vice president, corporate affairs, Westmin Resources Ltd., has reported assays from two more holes which extend the Battle Zone a significant distance to the East, at the Buttle Lake mine, 50 miles west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C.

Hole No. 18-300 extends the ore about 50 metres south of the last intersection on Section 18+70E and Hole No. 18-221 on Section 20+20E is a 150-meter stepout to the east.
