Westmin Resources Limited has reported it has obtained assay results from the recently reported intersection in the Battle Zone in the Buttle Lake mine, 50 miles west of Campbell River, Vancouver Island, B.C.

The intersection, while somewhat lower grade than visually estimated, is still good grade; and represents the thickest intersection drilled to date in the Battle Zone. This hole extends that zone an additional 15 metres to the east - towards the advancing 18 level access drift.

Drilling continues with four machines and one additional drill will soon be set up near the face of the 18 level access - at section 18 + 70E.
