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## SPOKANE RESOURCES LTD.

FIRST ASSAYS FOR 1995 PROGRAM CONFIRM - Spokane  
DIRECTION, ATTITUDE & STRIKE GOLD VEIN Resources  
has re-  
ported assay result from the first phase of 1995 drilling on the 100%-  
owned Rex Mountain gold/copper property, located at 2,500 metres  
elevation, 40 km. northwest of Lillooet, B.C. The \$650,000 drill  
program of 19,000 feet in 1995 is designed to extend the zone of  
mineralization both laterally and at depth. SEE TABLE OF ASSAYS  
OVERLEAF P.2

The Rex Mountain gold zone has been defined along a  
continuous strike length of 2,000 feet and to a depth of 300 feet. It  
is characterized by a series of mesothermal quartz veins containing  
chalcopyrite and pyrrhotite sulphides with associated gold  
mineralization. Previous drilling results, in 1994 vein intersections  
totalled 50, have shown the zone to be continuous in its character  
and grade along the strike length drilled.

**HIGHEST GRADES IN THE DEEPEST HOLES** - These drill results  
confirm that the gold-bearing quartz vein system is steeply dipping -  
73° to the north. All drill holes have been drilled to the south in  
order to penetrate the gold/copper-bearing quartz veins at or near true  
width. Diamond drill holes 95-2 and 95-4 were steeply inclined to  
test the quartz vein system below existing intersections. High  
values of both copper and gold in these drill holes indicates the  
mineralized system should continue at depth and may increase in  
grade. All of the above intersections and previous drill intersections  
in this area correlate well and appear to establish a continuous zone  
of quartz vein mineralization with significant values of both gold  
and copper. Drill holes 95-5 and 95-6 were abandoned at a shallow  
depth above the zone.

Diamond drilling on the Rex Mountain property will continue  
to extend the quartz vein system to the west and also at depth below  
previous drill intersections. Drilling is continuing as close as  
possible to 25-metre centres to provide data for a reserve calculation  
and a preliminary analysis of mining feasibility. (See GCNL No.89,
