## AGC AMERICAS GOLD CORP.

TOODOGGONE WORK UNDERWAY - Henry Meyer, president,  
reports AGC Americas

Gold Corp. has started its 1996 Phase one, 20,000-foot drill  
program on its 100%-owned JD gold discovery located 40 miles  
north of the Kemess mine in the Toodoggone region, 250 miles  
northwest of Smithers, north-central BC. Initial drilling will focus  
on extending the Finn zone through an area where Kidd Creek Mines  
in 1984 intersected 1.309 oz. gold/ton over 15.5 feet. AGC's last  
hole in 1995 in the vicinity intersected 0.448 oz. gold/ton over  
19.7 feet.

Detailed interpretation of the induced polarization surveys and  
other exploration data suggests the Finn zone extends 300 metres to  
the west. The zone also appears to be open to the east and at depth.

AGC has staked and/or acquired in excess of 54 square miles in  
this area based on 1994 discovery. (SEE GCNL NO.103, 28May96,
