TULSEQUAH CHIEF PROJECT - Terry Chandler, president, Redfern
NOW IN PUBLIC REVIEW Resources Ltd. reports the
Tulsequah Chief project has
entered the 60 day public review period proscribed by the
Environmental Assessment Act. Closing date for receipt of public
comments has been set at 6Nov97. The project is located about 100
km south of Atlin, northwest BC and about 60 km northeast of
Juneau, Alaska.

Redfern will seek to maximize public awareness and comment
on the Project Report through the public review period by means of
circulars, advertising and public meetings in Atlin, B.C.;
Whitehorse, Yukon; Skagway and Juneau, Alaska. The company has
also recently jointly selected with the Taku River Tlingit First
Nation an Aboriginal Liaison officer who will inform the First
Nation and gathering from members feedback to Redfern.

The Public Review period will be succeeded by a final 70 day
review by members of the Project Assessment Committee which
includes representatives from the state of Alaska, federal U.S.
agencies, Government of Canada, provincial government, Yukon
government, Atlin community and the Taku River Tlingit First
Nation. At the end of the review the Project Committee will pass
their recommendations on to the B.C. Minister of Employment and
Investment and the Minister of Environment. It is expected the
referral to the Ministers will take place by mid-January, 1998. (SEE
